







## ***CAL Belle Blanket – Part 2***



### **COLORS:**

Material - Superstar od Etrofil in 4 colors :

**72192 Orange 3ks = C1**

**72006 Rust 3ks = C2**

**77013 Brown 3ks = C3**

**74065 Khaki 3ks =C4**

– the yarns can find in our eshop [SUPERSTAR](https://www.superstar.cz) + hook 5,00mm – 8/0

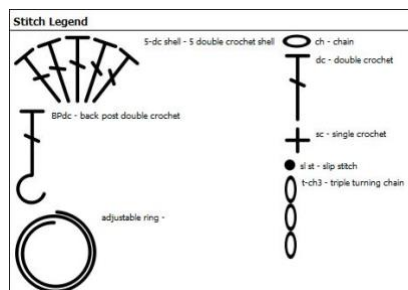
The colors alternate in the exact sequence as stated in the legend. You can cut and connect the new color after each row – I chose to pull the thread on the back – see below – without sewing the ends.

If you are using wool without alternating 4 different threads/yarns, continue crocheting the pattern smoothly without following the color change.

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## ABBREVIATIONS:



**CORNER** – into the ch3 corner space make – **2dc, ch3, 2dc**

## Pattern

We finished the first part with row 8 and **Rust** color and have 39 stitches on the side + corner chain stitches. Continue with **Brown** in row 9

**Row 9** – ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make „\*dc, ch1 and skip1\* - this pattern repeat until the last st before the chain space, dc and CORNER“ – repeat pattern between „“ on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 43 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 188 stitches)

**Row 10** – ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*dc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 47 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 204 stitches)

**Row 11** – ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, „skip2 and to the next st make 5dc-shell, skip2 and make \*dc, skip2 sts and to the next st make 5dc-shell and skip2 sts\* - this pattern between \*-\* repeat 6 more time and to the corner chain space make – CORNER“ - repeat pattern between „“ on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 51 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 220 stitches)

**Row 12** - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space,, then make „dc, \*dc, ch2 and sc to the 3rd dc in the middle of the shell, ch2\* - this repeat 8 times, then 2dc and CORNER“ - - repeat pattern between „“ on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 55 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 236 stitches)

**Row 13** - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*dc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 59 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 252 stitches)

**Row 14** - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make „\*dc, ch1 and skip1\* - this pattern repeat until the last st before the chain space, dc and CORNER“ – repeat pattern between „“ on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 63 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 268 stitches)

**Row 15** - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*dc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 67 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 284 stitches)

**Row 16** - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*BPdc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 71 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 300 stitches)

**Here ends the second part of the pattern. There will be a change in the next part, so stay tuned for the third part.**

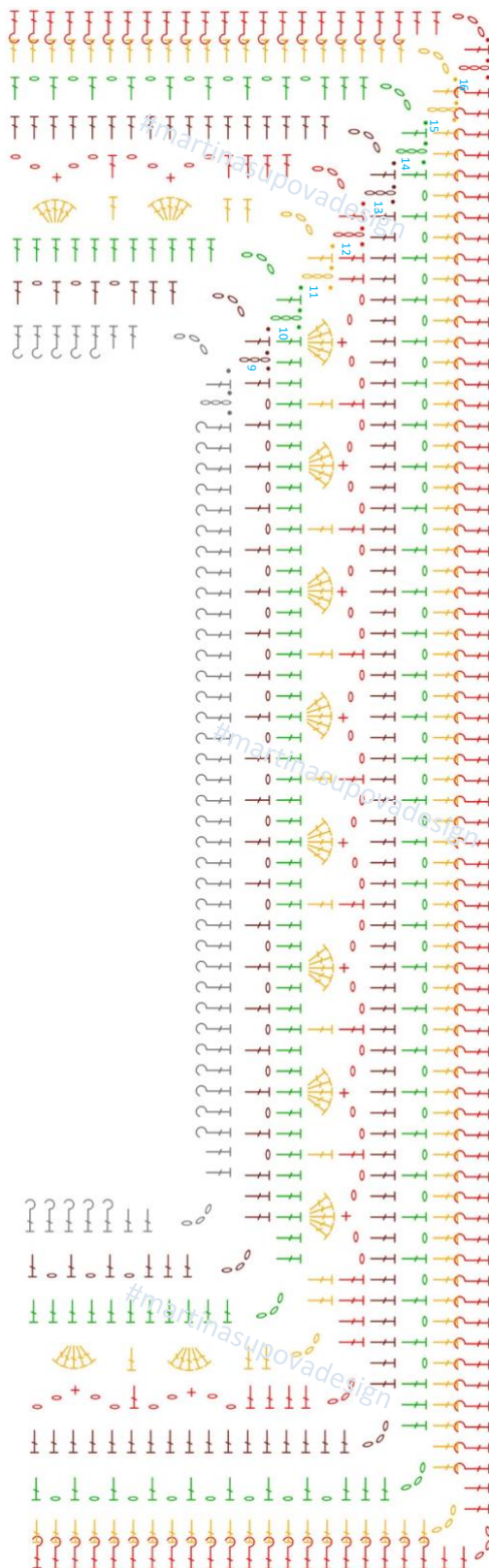
