


## CAL Belle Blanket – Part 3



## **COLORS:**



Material - Superstar od Etrofil in 4 colors:

72192 Orange 3ks = C1

72006 Rust 3ks = C2

77013 Brown 3ks = C3

74065 Khaki 3ks =C4

- the yarns cans find in our eshop  $\underline{\text{SUPERSTAR}}$  + hook 5,00mm - 8/0


The colors alternate in the exact sequence as stated in the legend. You can cut and connect the new color after each row – I chose to pull the thread on the back – see below – without sewing the ends.

If you are using wool without alternating 4 different threads/yarns, continue crocheting the pattern smoothly without following the color change.

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## ABBREVIATIONS:



CORNER - into the ch3 corner space make - 2dc,ch3,2dc

## Pattern

We finished the second part with row 16 and Rust color and have 71 stitches on the side + corner chain stitches. Continue with Brown in

Row 17 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make ,,\*dc, ch1 and skip1\* - this pattern repeat until the last st before the chain space, dc and CORNER" - repeat pattern between ,," on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 75 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 316 stiches)

Row 18 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*dc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 79 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 332 stiches)

Row 19 - ch3,dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, "dc, skip2 and to the next st make 5dc-shell, skip2 and make \*dc, skip2 sts and to the next st make 5dc-shell and skip2 sts\* - this pattern between \*-\* repeat 11 more time, then dc and to the corner chain space make -CORNER" - repeat pattern between ,," on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 83 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 348 stiches)

Row 20 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space,, then make "2dc, \*dc, ch2 and sc to the 3rd dc in the middle of the shell, ch2\* this repeat 13 times, then 3dc and CORNER" - - repeat pattern between ,," on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 87 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 364 stiches)

Row 21 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*dc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 91 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 380 stiches)

Row 22 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make ",\*dc, ch1 and skip1\* - this pattern repeat until the last st before the chain space, dc and CORNER" - repeat pattern between ,," on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 95 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 396 stiches)

Row 23 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*dc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 99 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 412 stiches)

Row 24 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make \*BPdc to each st until the corner and CORNER\* - repeat this pattern between th \*-\* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 103 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts = 428 stiches)

Here ends the third part of the pattern. There will be a change in the next part, so stay tuned for the fourth part.
