


CAL Belle Blanket - Part 4



COLORS:



Material - Superstar od Etrofil in 4 colors:

72192 Orange 3ks = C1 72006 Rust 3ks = C2 77013 Brown 3ks = C3

74065 Khaki 3ks =C4

- the yarns cans find in our eshop $\underline{\text{SUPERSTAR}}$ + hook 5,00mm - 8/0


The colors alternate in the exact sequence as stated in the legend. You can cut and connect the new color after each row – I chose to pull the thread on the back – see below – without sewing the ends.

If you are using wool without alternating 4 different threads/yarns, continue crocheting the pattern smoothly without following the color change.

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ABBREVIATIONS:



CORNER - into the ch3 corner space make - 2dc,ch3,2dc

Pattern

We finished the second part with row 24 and Rust color and have 103 stitches on the side + corner chain stitches. Continue with Brown in row 25

Row 25 – ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make "*dc, ch1 and skip1* - this pattern repeat until the last st before the chain space, dc and CORNER" - repeat pattern between ,," on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 107 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Row 26 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make *dc to each st until the corner and CORNER* - repeat this pattern between th *-* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 111 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Row 27 - ch3, ch3 and dc into the corner chain space, ,, skip1 and to the next st make 5dc-shell, skip2 and make *dc, skip2 sts and to the next st make 5dc-shell and skip2 sts* - this pattern between *-* repeat 17 more time, then to the corner chain space make - dc,ch1,dc" - repeat pattern between "on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 115 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Row 28 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space,, then make ,, *dc, ch2 and sc to the 3rd dc in the middle of the shell, ch2* - this repeat 19 times, then dc and CORNER" - - repeat pattern between ,," on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 119 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Row 29 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make *dc to each st until the corner and CORNER* - repeat this pattern between th *-* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 123 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Row 30 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make ",*dc, ch1 and skip1* - this pattern repeat until the last st before the chain space, dc and CORNER" - repeat pattern between ,," on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 127 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Row 31 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make *dc to each st until the corner and CORNER* - repeat this pattern between th *-* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 131 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Row 32 - ch3, dc, ch3 and 2dc into the corner chain space, then make *BPdc to each st until the corner and CORNER* - repeat this pattern between th *-* on all sides of the square and close the row with a sl st into the third st at the beginning of this row. (= 135 sts on each side + 4x corner chain sts)

Here ends the fourth part of the pattern. There will be a change in the next part, so stay tuned for the fifth

End of the fourth part, the next part will be published on October 15th

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The BLACK marked part of 6 stitches is repeated in the instructions 14x times and then the pattern continues as shown in the diagram In the remaining rows, crochet the pattern continuously across the entire side (also in the unmarked (14x6 stitches) as shown in the diagram

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
