


WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 Magic Ball 1000m 4-ply by ColorfulLmadeshop on photo Coast V. https://www.colorfullmade-shop/1000m-c25 250 2.htm (since the parts of this pattern can be repeated more times than in the original size for 1000m, you can also use a ball with a higher winding)
- hook 3,50 mm (6/0)

Scarf size when using the recommended material 170 x 80 cm

ABBREVIATIONS:



MIDDLE – into the middle 3-chain space – 2dc,ch3,2dc

Pattern

Start with a magic (adjustable) ring, into which make the first basic row – ZR1

ZR1 - ch4, 3dc, ch3, 3dc, ch1 and dc (= 3 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

ZR2 - ch4, 2dc into the chain space, dc to the next 3 sts, MIDDLE, dc to the next 3 sts, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 7 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

Row 1 – ch4, 2dc into the chain space, then pattern *dc, ch1 and skip1* - repeat in total 3 times, dc, MIDDLE, then pattern *dc, ch1 and skip1* - repeat in total 3 times, dc, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 11 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

Row 2 – ch4, 2dc into the chain space, then make dc to each stich, MIDDLE, then agian make dc to each stich, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 15 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

Row 3 – ch4, dc to the chain space, skip1 and 5-dc shell to the next stich, skip2 and then pattern *dc, skip2 and to the next stich 5-dc shell and again skip2 sts* - this pattern between *-* repeat 1 more time, then to the middle chain space make - dc,ch3,dc. On the other side of the work, skip1 st and into the next make 5-dc shell, skip2 and then pattern *dc, skip2 and to the next stich 5-dc shell and again skip2 sts* - this pattern between *-* repeat 1 more time, then to the chain st make dc, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 19 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

Row 4 - ch4, 2dc into the chain space, then pattern *dc, ch2 and sc to the third dc in the middle of the shell, ch2* - this repeat in total 3 times, then dc, MIDDLE, then again pattern *dc, ch2 and sc to the third dc in the middle of the shell, ch2* - this repeat in total 3 times, then dc, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 23 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)




Row 5 - ch4, 2dc into the chain space, then make dc to each stich, MIDDLE, then agian make dc to each stich, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 27 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

Row 6 - ch4, 2dc into the chain space, then pattern *dc, ch1 and skip1* - repeat in total 13 times, dc, MIDDLE, then pattern *dc, ch1 and skip1* - repeat in total 13 times, dc, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 31 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

Row 7 - ch4, 2dc into the chain space, then make dc to each stich, MIDDLE, then agian make dc to each stich, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 35 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)

Row 8 - ch4, 2dc into the chain space, then make FPdc to each stich, MIDDLE, then agian make FPdc to each stich, 2dc to the chain stich, ch1 and dc to the last stich (= 39 + 2 stiches on the side + ch3 in the middle)
