



## ***Rainbow Baby Blanket***



### ***You will need:***

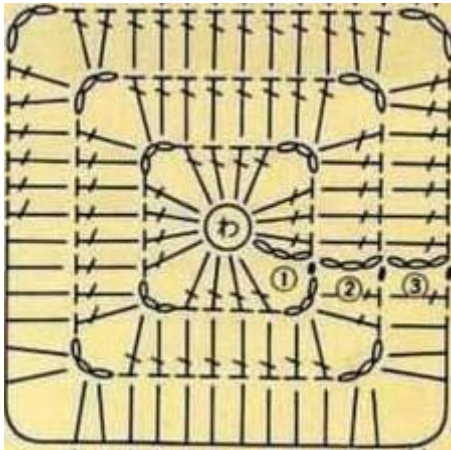
- 10 skeins of Baby Uni Grundl, 50g/150 m, 70% Polyamide, 30% Polacrylic
- 3 skeins of white and 1 each of yellow, orange, light pink, lavender, light blue, turquoise and mint
- 4mm crochet hook

Approximate size 80x120 cm



**Square schematic:**

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ⌋ = double crochet (dc)



16 squares- color yellow

17 squares - color orange

17 squares - color light pink

17 squares - color lavender

17 squares - color light blue

17 squares - color turquoise

17 squares - color mint

117 squares all together

**Pattern:**

Start each square with a magic ring

Make 117 squares according to pattern with a 4mm hook. Every square has 3 rows of coloured yarn and 1 row of DCs with white yarn (see row 4 in pattern)

9 x 13 squares

Start in the right corner and add squares -

1 yellow, 2 orange, 3 pink, 4 lavender, 5 blue, 6 turquoise, 7 mint, 8 yellow, 9 orange, 9 pink, 9 lavender, 9 blue, 9 turquoise, 8 mint, 7 yellow, 6 orange, 5 pink, 4 lavender, 3 blue, 2 turquoise, 1 mint



Connecting squares-

1. sew together from wrong side
2. crochet together from wrong side with single crochet through front loops

After connecting all squares make a border with DCs, in the corner make ( 2DC, CH2, 2DC), that will make the corner space smaller.
